The above Lot designation is in Pleasant Valley Farm Tracts, as designated, numbered and described on the official plat thereof now on record in the Office of the County Clerk of Jackson County.

An order of the State Engineer entered June 6, 1975, approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 13.2 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to James Trefren and recorded at page 32787, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
