CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **MERLE GILBERT AND F. BURTON**

of **Merlin**, State of **Oregon, 97532**, has
a right to the use of the waters of **Bummer Gulch**

a tributary of **Quartz Creek** for the purpose of
irrigation of **4.0 acres**

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the **WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR**, in Volume **16**, at page **523**; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from **February, 1907**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.06 cubic foot per
second**.

The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 5, T. 35 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

**4.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 5
T. 35 S., R. 6 W., W. M.**

An order of the State Engineer entered August 7, 1974, approved a change
in point of diversion for the irrigation of 4.4 acres. This certificate
is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and
supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Merle Gilbert and F. Burton
recorded at page 32996, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
