CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That WALBURGA LACHNER

of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Powder River, tributary of Snake River and Springs in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 34 for the purpose of the irrigation of 101.5 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1887 for Tract No. 1, July 5, 1902 for Tract No. 2 and 1887 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

* Tract No. 1 from Powder River: 11.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Sixteen, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian;

Tract No. 2 from Powder River: 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty-four, Township Eight South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian;

Tract No. 3 from Springs in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 34: 10 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-four, Township Seven South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described:
