**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **LESLIE G. & VERA L. ESPE**

of **3186 Leland Road, Sunny Valley**, State of Oregon, **97478**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, an unnamed stream, and a reservoir constructed under Application No. R-49047, Permit No. R-5939 a tributary of **Grave Creek** for the purpose of domestic use for one family and supplemental irrigation of **1.2 acres**

under Permit No. **36630** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **March 8, 1972**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.025 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use and 0.02 c.f.s. from stream and reservoir for supplemental irrigation**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 33, T. 33 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Spring - 150 feet North and 1470 feet West; Stream - 30 feet North and 1350 feet West; both from S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Corner, Section 33.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5939,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Domestic and 1.2 acres NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
 Section 4  
 T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W. M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
