CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That FRED LAMPRECHT

of Haines, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Powder River, tributary of Snake River and Pine Creek, tributary of
Powder River
for the purpose of the irrigation of 42 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880 for 13.5 acres; 1888 for
8.5 acres and 1902 for 20 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot
per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

15.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 26.5 acres in
the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty, Township Eight South,
Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
