CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MRS. J. T. LANDRETH

of Baker, State of Oregon 97814 has a right to the use of the waters of Old Settlers Slough and Salmon Creek, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 41.75 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891 for Tract No. 1 and 1892 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1 from Old Settlers Slough: 1.75 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Eight, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2 from Salmon Creek: 20 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 20 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-five, Township Eight South, Range Thirty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
