and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1869 for 60 acres; 1865 for
157 acres and 1890 for 25 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 20 acres in the Scutheast quarter of Northwest quarter; of Section Thirty-two: 22 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 27 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 20 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 13 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty-one, 140 acres in the Northwest quarter of Section Thirty-two, Township Eight South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Raker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
