CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That POND - A - BASS
A. CURTIS LAMB, Partner

of 1289 SW Levens St., Dallas, State of Oregon, 97338, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-47394, Permit No. R-5711, a tributary of Fern Creek (Little Luckiamute River) for the purpose of fish culture

under Permit No. 35525 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 12, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Hart DLC 39, Section 25, T. 8 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 2810 feet South and 810 feet East from NW Corner, Hart DLC 39.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
