**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **EUGENE M. KEY**

of Milton-Freewater, State of Oregon, 97862, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 1

a tributary of Pine Creek (Walla Walla River) for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 80.0 acres

under Permit No. U-452 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 27, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, T. 6 N., R. 34 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

An order of the State Engineer entered April 18, 1963, canceled the right for the irrigation of 40.0 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Howard S. Murray and recorded at Page 22882, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
