CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Stanley & Maurice Weishaar 97850

of Route 2, Box 2689, La Grande , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of five wells

a tributary of Grand Ronde River for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 986.6 acres under Permit No. G-4428 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 13, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 10.75 cubic feet per second, being 1.48 c.f.s. from No. 1, 3.30 c.f.s. from No. 2, 3.30 c.f.s. from No. 4, and 2.67 c.f.s. from No. 5, with any deficiency in the available supply from well No. 5 for irrigation of lands tabulated under well No. 5 to be made up by appropriation from wells 1 and 3 provided the quantity appropriated from well No. 3 shall not exceed 0.89 c.f.s. and the total quantity appropriated for these lands shall not exceed the limitations of the duty of water as fixed herein.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the #1-NEX SEX, Section 7, #2-NEX SEX, #3-NEX SWX, Section 5, #4-NEX SEX, Section 8, #5-SWX NEX, Section 6, T. 3 S., R. 39 E., W. M., #1-1350 feet North and 30 feet West from SE Corner, Section 7, #2-1330 feet North *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ona-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
