CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **CBERG BROS.**

of Rt. 1 Box 217, **Carlton**, State of **Oregon, 97111**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-47127, Permit No. R-5592

a tributary of **Yamhill River** for the purpose of recreation and fish culture

under Permit No. **34938** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **June 25, 1970**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.25 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **McBride DLC 57**, Section 19, T. 3 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 1660 feet South and 1260 feet West from **NE Corner, Section 19.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
