CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **MILTON E. ROWLAND**

of P.O. Box 1017, Philomath, State of Oregon, 97370, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Greasy Creek and Milts Pond constructed under Application No. R-50764, Permit No. R-5972 a tributary of Mary's River for the purpose of fish culture and irrigation of 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 36801 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 28, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.016 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from Greasy Creek and reservoir for fish culture and 0.006 c.f.s. from Greasy Creek for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, T. 13 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Creek-2370 feet South and 390 feet East; Reservoir-2280 feet South and 470 feet East; both from N $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5972,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Fish culture and 0.5 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 6
T. 13 S., R. 6 W., W. M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
