CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **ROBERT C. NAEF**

of 13231 SE Nixon Avenue, Milwaukie, State of Oregon, 97222, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Clackamas River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 0.8 acre

under Permit No. 32770 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 24, 1967 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within John Foster DLC 41, Section 21, T. 2 S., R. 3 E., W. M., 860 feet South and 1450 feet West from NE Corner, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within John Foster DLC 41
Domestic and 0.6 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within Ambrose D. Foster DLC 43
Section 21
T. 2 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
