CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L. R. PETERS

of Route 3, Box 541, Aurora , State of Oregon, 97002 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unmamed stream and 1.795 acre feet from Peters Pond constructed under Application No. R-48517, Permit No. R-5891 a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of stock, irrigation of 8.3 acres, and supplemental irrigation of 29.0 acres

under Permit No. 36402 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 30, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for stock, 0.10 c.f.s. for irrigation, and 1.795 acre feet for supplemental irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW's SW's, Section 18, T. 4 S., R. 1 E., W. M., stream-1420 feet North and 1150 feet East; pond-1450 feet North and 1040 feet East; both from the SW Corner of Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5891, and further limited to the use of stored water only on the lands described as supplemental;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Primary - unnamed stream and reservoir
Stock and 8.3 acres NWt SWk
Section 18

Supplemental - reservoir only

1.4 acres NWt SWt

27.6 acres SWt SWt

T. 4 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
