of Box 123, Brightwood , State of Oregon, 97011 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Kloshe Chuck Reservoir constructed under Application

No. R-51238, Permit No. R-6104

a tributary of Sandy River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and mesthetic purposes

under Permit No. 37713 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 17, 1973 for domestic; May 21, 1974 for aesthetic purposes that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f... from the unnamed stream for domestic use and 0.01 c.f... from the unnamed stream and reservoir for aesthetic purposes

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Stream-SE's NE's, Section 33; Reservoir-SE's NE's, Section 34, T. 2 S., R. 7 E., W. H., Stream-North 50 degrees 59 minutes West 343 feet; Reservoir-South 2 degrees 21 minutes 09 seconds East 304 feet; both from the Wk Corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _______ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and Aesthetic Purposes NWk SWk Section 34 T. 2 S., R. 7 E., W. H.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Folicy Review Board.
