## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

GEORGE W. SMITH

of Box 206, Coos River Route, Coos Bay, State of Oregon, 97420, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Smith Creek and a spring

a tributary of Coos River for the purpose of irrigation of 49.1 acres, domestic use for three families, and stock

under Permit No. 33989 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 25, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second, being 0.32 c.f.s. from Smith Creek for irrigation, 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock from the spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Creek-Lot 3 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Spring- NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 27, T. 25 S., R. 12 W., W. M., Creek-530 feet North and 1650 feet West; 1750 feet South and 1450 feet West; Spring-1250 feet South and 3420 feet West; all from E $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic, Stock, and 0.3 acre Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 26  
8.5 acres Lot 3 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Domestic, Stock, and 31.0 acres Lot 4 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Stock NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.7 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 27

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
