CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CLAY AND PEGGY HUGHES AND
JOHN R. AND CARYL S. PHILLIPS

of W. Coos River, Box 644, Coos Bay, State of Oregon, 97420, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and West Fork Millicoma River

a tributary of Millicoma River for the purpose of domestic use for two families and irrigation of 0.25 acre

under Permit No. 36163 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

October 9, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. from West Fk. Millicoma River for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the River-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31; Stream-Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 31, T. 24 S., R. 11 W., W. M., River-310 feet South and 1195 feet West; Stream-302.2 feet South and 1403.3 feet West; both from N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the Water Resources Director.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.25 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 31
T. 24 S., R. 11 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
