CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **WARREN T. BRAINARD**

of Rt. 4 Box 129, Coos Bay, State of Oregon, 97420, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-48659, Permit No. R-5901, a tributary of Catching Inlet for the purpose of Domestic use for two families

under Permit No. 36494 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 11 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 31, T. 25 S., R. 12 W., W. M., 280 feet North and 20 feet East from W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 11 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 Lot 12 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 Section 31
 T. 25 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
