a tributary of Umpqua River domestic use for one family and irrigation of 0.8 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34475 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 20, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0-02 cubic foot per second, being 0-01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0-01 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWX SWk, as projected within Foster DLC 43, Section 13, T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 2220 feet North and 640 feet East from SW Corner, Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre NWt SWt
Domestic and 0.5 acre SWt SWt
Both as projected within Foster DLC 43
Section 13
T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
