CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **CLAIRE O. BROWN**

of **P.O. Box 91, Williams**, State of Oregon, **97544**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of **three wells**

a tributary of **Cherry Gulch (W. Fork Williams Cr.)** for the purpose of irrigation of **1.3 acres and supplemental irrigation of 12.1 acres**

under Permit No. **G-3077** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **November 22, 1965**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.17 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. from Well #1, 0.07 c.f.s. from Well #2, and 0.08 c.f.s. from Well #3**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Wells No. 1 and No. 3-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; Well No. 2-SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Well No. 1-1260 feet North and 2610 feet West, Well No. 2-290 feet North and 730 feet West, Well No. 3-360 feet North and 2600 feet West, all from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 2.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eighth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
