CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

LOY W. BREON

of Star Route, Siletz , State of Oregon, 97380 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Blossom Creek and spring stresm

a tributary of Siletz River irrigation of 1.1 acres and domestic use for one family

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 30762 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 19, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from Blossom Creek for irright ion and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring stream for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (E's NE's NE's) and Lot 7 (E's NE's NE's), Section 1,

T. 10 S., R. 10 W., W. M., spring stream-900 feet South and 1780 feet West;

Blossom Creek-1430 feet South and 2930 feet West; 1550 feet South and 2820 feet
West; all from NE Corner, Lot 3 (E's NE's NE's), Section 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.3 acre Lot 6 (Wh NEW NWW)

0.3 acre Lot 7 (EN NWW NWW)

0.3 acre Lot 10 (EN SWW NWW)

0.2 acre Lot 11 (Wh SEN NWW)

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
