CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **GENE FISHER**

of **Rr. 1 Box 217 A, Sheridan**, State of **Oregon, 97378**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of **Rowell Creek**

a tributary of **Gooseneck Creek** for the purpose of **domestic use for one family**

under Permit No. **35986** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **February 23, 1971**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Kennedy DLC 48**, Section **31**, T. **6 S.**, R. **6 W.**, W. M., **150 feet South and 340 feet East from the SW Corner of Eldridge DLC 47.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
