CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE H. BITTNER

of Rt. 1 Box 231 A, Sheridan , State of Oregon, 97378 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Gooseneck Creek and a spring

a tributary of Mill Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family and stock

under Permit No. 37033 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 7, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from Gooseneck Creek for stock and 0.005 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use with any deficiency in the available supply from the spring for domestic use to be made up by appropriation from * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Cr.-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; Spr.-NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Both projected within Robinson DLC 49, Section 31, T. 6 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Cr.-190 feet South and 360 feet East; Spr.-1970 feet North and 500 feet East, both from SE Corner, Eldridge DLC 47.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Gooseneck Creek, provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources for domestic use shall not exceed 0.005 c.f.s.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
