This Is to Certify, That

HAROLD P. SCHWEITZER

of 28877 S. Needy Rd., Canby, proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unmamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-44367,

Permit No. R-5098
a tributary of Willamette River
for the purpose of irrigation of 36.0 acres and fish culture

under Permit No. 32980 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

January 5. 1968 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second, being 0.45 c.f.s. for irrigation from stream and 0.05 c.f.s. from stream and reservoir for fish culture

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWk SEk, as projected within Fish DLC 45, Section 27, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 1550 feet North and 1140 feet East from the SW Corner, Fish DLC 45.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fish culture and 5.0 acres SWk SEk Fish culture and 14.0 acres SEk SEk Both projected within Fish DLC 45 Section 27

Fish culture and 12.7 acres NEZ NEZ Fish culture and 4.3 acres NWZ NEZ Both projected within Fish DLC 45 Section 34 T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
