of 14120 SE Parmenter Drive, Milwaukie , State of Oregon, 97222 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Kellogg Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-46800, Permit No. R-5595

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 1.0 acre and recreation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34943 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 11, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation from Kellogg Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. for recreation from Creek and reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SET SET, as projected within Kellogg DLC 55, Section 6, T. 2 S., R. 2 E., W. M., Creek-970 feet North and 20 feet West, Reservoir-1200 feet North and 240 feet West, both from SE Corner, Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
