## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

Permit A-5M-1-76

GREG CORREY

of Rt 3 Box 547 Aurora , State of Oregon 97002 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a reservoir constructed under Application No. R-48754, Permit No. R-5915

a tributary of Netter Creek for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 33.9 acres

under Permit No. 36567 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 7, 1972

that the amount of sustant to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre feet

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL SEL, Section 13, T. 4 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 2500 feet North and 410 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_of one cubic foot per second per unit a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from the reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5915, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
