domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to

exceed 3 acre in area and stock under Permit No. 36685 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. 36685 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

February 17, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.005 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, Section 8, T. 28 S., R. 13 W., W. M., 230 feet North and 790 feet East from the Center of Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
