CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

W. E. AND JOAN CORRELL

of Cavitt Creek Road, Glide , State of Oregon, 97463 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Evants Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-52650, Permit No. R-6115 a tributary of Cavitt Creek for the purpose of icrigation of 6.2 acres

under Permit No. 37767 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

July 29, 1974
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW NEL, Section 23, T. 27 S., R. 3 W., W. M., Creek-950 feet South and 710 feet East; Reservoir-750 feet South and 260 feet East; both from N'x Corner, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 25 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 6.2 acres NWt NEt Section 23 T. 27 S., R. 3 W., W. H.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
