CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of 1869 Hidden village Place, Medford , State of Oregon, 97501 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean

for the purpose of

domestic use for one family and the irrigation of 1.1 acres

and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

April 25, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL Swk, Section 33, T. 33 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 380 feet North and 70 feet West from the SE Corner, NE' SWk, Section 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 42 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Domestic and 1.1 acres NE's SW's Section 33 T. 33 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
