CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That A. LONG

of Haines, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Big Muddy Creek and Rock Creek, tributaries of Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 334 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the ^{Baker} STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886 for 40 acres; 1900 for
14 acres; 1872 for 160 acres and 1879 for 120 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $\frac{1}{40}$ of one cubic foot
per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 14 acres in the
Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty, Township Seven South,
Range Thirty-nine; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and
40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-six;
40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 40 acres in the South-
east quarter of Southwest quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of South-
east quarter of Section Twenty-three; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of
Northeast quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of
Section Twenty-six, Township Seven South, Range Thirty-eight; All East of Wil-
lamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
