CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GARY W. SEIDEL

of 91812 Deadwood Cr. Rd., Deadwood, State of Oregon, 97430, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of spring stream

a tributary of Deadwood Creek for the purpose of stock and domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 30902 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 14, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for stock and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T. 16 S., R. 9 W., W. M., 150 feet South and 1820 feet East from NW Corner, Section 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per ac. e.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
