## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

GEORGE KINTT'A

, State of Oregon, 97357 of Star Route, , has made Logsden proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Mill Creek and a spring stream

a tributary of Siletz River

for the purpose of

domestic use for two families and the irrigation of 1.1 acres

under Permit No. 36041 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

July 6, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use from spring stream and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation from Mill Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 14 (Et SWt NEt); Lot 15 (Wt SEt NEt), Section 33, T. 9 S., R. 9 N., W. M., Mill Cr.-2750 feet North and 920 feet East; Spring Stream-3040 feet North and 1610 feet East; both from the S% Corner, Section 33, T. 9 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2^{i_2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Domestic and 1.1 acres Lot 14 (Et SWt NEt) Section 33 T. 9 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
