CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. S. LOVE

of Keating, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Powder River, tributary of Snake River and Goose Creek, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 176 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903 for 73 acres; 1869 for 95 acres and 1885 for 8 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

18 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-six, Township Eight South, Range Forty-two; 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 25 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-one; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 8 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-two, and 15 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-three, Township Eight South, Range Forty-three East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
