or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEZ NWZ, Section 7, T. 2 S., R. 7 W., W. M., North 89 degrees 19 minutes East 2300 feet from the NE Corner of Section 12, T. 2 S., R. 8 W., W. M.
