## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** OREGON STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION  
LANDSCAPE SECTION, CONSTRUCTION DIVISION

of State Highway Building, Salem, State of Oregon, 97310, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of roadside rest area

under Permit No. G-2951 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 7, 1965 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, being 0.055 c.f.s. from each well

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Well No. 1-SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Well No. 2-NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Section 35, T. 3 S., R. 1 W., W. M., Well No. 1-2080 feet South and 1330 feet West; Well No. 2-990 feet South and 1320 feet West; both from the SE Corner, Boon DLC 42.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
