This Is to Certify, That ARTHUR S. DUHAIME

of Rt. 1 Box 85 A, Brookings , State of Oregon, 97415 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Winchuck River and spring

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 0.5 acre and domestic use for one family

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 37745 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 15, 1974 for irrigation and October 23, 1974 for domestic use that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation from Vinchuck River and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use from the spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEŁ NEŁ, Section 26; SEŁ SEŁ, Section 23, T. 41 S., R. 13 W., W. M., Spring-550 feet South and 550 feet West; River-170 feet North and 1250 feet West; both from the SE Corner of Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
