CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LAWRENCE A. AND RACHEL R. BAKER

of 63011 O.B. Riley Rd., Bend , State of Oregon, 97701 , has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Deschutes River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of
domestic use for house and cabin and stock use

under Permit No. 30730 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
August 11, 1965 for domestic in house, February 8, 1966 for domestic in cabin and *
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W. M.,
117 feet North 60 degrees West from the Center of Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second
per acre.

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies
