of 3172 Woodland Park Rd., Grants Pass . State of Oregon, 97526 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed drainageway and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-47948, Permit No. R-5810

a tributary of Baum Slough (Applegate River) irrigation of 5.2 acres and stock

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35949 und that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 11, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for stock and 0.07 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWE NEE, Section 32, T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 400 feet North and 1980 feet West from the Et Corner of Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited tone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 42 acre fact per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5810;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Stock and 5.2 acres SWk NEW Section 32 T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
