CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLARENCE Z. AND DORIS E. SMITH

of 630 SE Peoria Blvd., Corvallis, State of Oregon, 97330, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director. of a right to the use of the waters of East River Channel

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 85.0 acres

under Permit No. 37007 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 21, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.98 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the #1-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within P. Robinett DLC 71; #2-NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Robinett DLC 76, Section 1, T. 12 S., R. 5 W., W. M., #1-1110 feet South and 410 feet East; #2-2080 feet South and 280 feet East; both from the SE Corner, Earl DLC 75.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
