CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CHARLES P. BURNHAM

of Rt. 1 Box 142 A, Aurora , State of Oregon, 97002 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Case Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-44864, Permit No. R-5480

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 20.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34416 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Hay 8, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second from Case Creek and 10.65 acre feet stored water from reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWk SWk, as projected within Kennedy DLC 48 and SWk SWk, as projected within Gauthiers DLC 81, Section 24, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M., Dem-1790 feet North and 330 feet East; Pump-880 feet North and 580 feet East; both from the NV Corner, Jackson DLC 51.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flew policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
