of Baker , State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Pine Creek, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 222.8 acros of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872 for 36 acres; 1885 for 57
acres; 1893 for 92 acres and 1905 for 37.8 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic fool per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

30.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast cuarter and 27.3 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirteen:

Township Eight South, Range Thirty-eight: 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Eight South, Range Thirty-nine, All East of Willamette Merican, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use kerein described.
