CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CHAS. B. MAYS

of North Powder, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Clover Creek, Stevens Pasture Springs and Kaylor Springs, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 146 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1877

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 22 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 15 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 12 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 24 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 7 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 11 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 13 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Eighteen; 20 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 4 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 3 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Seventeen, Township Five South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Union County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
