CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES R. AND ROBERT J. DRURY

, State of Oregon, 97401 , has made of McKenzie Bridge proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Taylor Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-45215. Permit No. R-5289

a tributary of Horse Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation of 4.3 acres and fish culture

under Permit No. 33483 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 29, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 c.f.s. from Taylor Creek for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. from Taylor Creek and reservoir for fish culture

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL NWL, Section 22, T. 16 S., R. 5 E., W. M., Reservoir-530 feet North and 290 feet West; Creek-90 feet North and 60 feet West; both from the SE Corner, NE's NWk, Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Fish culture and 4.3 acres NE's NW's Section 22 T. 16 S., R. 5 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies 'established by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed
