CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DYROL JAY BURLESON

of 438 W. 9th, Albany , State of Oregon, 97321 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring and reservois constructed under Application No. R-46446, Permit No. R-5558 a tributary of Middle Fork Willamette River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and fish and wildlife

under Permit No. 34800 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

September 26, 1969
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use from spring and 0.01 c.f.s. for fish and wildlife from spring and reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEŁ NEŁ, Section 19, T. 19 S., R. 1 E., W. M., Spring-520 feet South and 950 feet East; Reservoir-950 feet South and 950 feet East; both from the NW Corner, NEŁ NEŁ, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _______of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
