## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** MRS. JULIAN SUSTELLO  
C/O WYATT'S TIRE COMPANY

of 390 11th Avenue West, Eugene, State of Oregon, 97401, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Amazon Diversion Channel and Fern Ridge Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625 a tributary of Long Tom River for the purpose of irrigation of 66.8 acres

under Permit No. 35112 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 1, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.84 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Channel-SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Breeding DLC 55, Section 24, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Fern Ridge Reservoir Dam-NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Channel-1650 feet South from the NW Corner, NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625 and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-7008 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
