under Permit No. G-4679 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 13, 1969 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (SW\(\) SW\(\)), Section 31, T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 520 feet North and 2010 feet East from the SW Corner, Lot 6 (SW\(\) SE\(\)), Section 36, T. 11 S., R. 5 W., W. M.,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighticthof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
