CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

SAMUEL H. LEE

of 515 Highway 101, Astoria , State of Oregon, 97103 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-44074,

Permit No. R-5029 with any deficiency in the available supply from the stream and a tributary of Nehalem River for the purpose of waterfowl attraction, recreation, and fish culture

under Permit No. 32735 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 24, 1967 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW: NEx), Lot 3 (NW: SEx), Section 12, T. 5 N., R. 7 W., W. M., River-2500 feet South and 2460 feet West; Reservoir-2920 feet South and 1860 feet West; both from the NE Corner of Section 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ————— of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 2 (SWk NE%) Lot 3 (NWk SE%) Section 12 T. 5 N., R. 7 W., W. M.

* reservoir to be made up by appropriation from the Nehalem River provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
