CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

JAMES R. HADISON

, State of Oregon, 97462 of Kellogg Star Route, Box 102, Oakland , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 24.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 33194 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 26, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEG SWG, as projected within Laughlin DLC 43, Section 20, T. 23 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 2200 feet North and 600 feet East from the NW Corner, Kellogg DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 16.5 acres NEW SWA 8.4 scres SEk SWk 0.1 acre NW SEk All projected within Laughlin DLC 43 Section 20 T. 23 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed
