a tributary of Lost Creek irrigation of 35.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-4283 and that said right to the use of said wat. has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 16, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX SWA, as projected within Barbre DLC 47, Section 21, T. 19 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 2700 feet South and 1450 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others:

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
