and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. G-2975 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 14, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.47 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWZ NWZ, as projected within Moore DLC 66, Section 36, T. 11 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 3410 feet North and 2400 feet West from the SN Corner, Lot 6 (SW SEL), Section 36.

The senount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighticth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
